GENERAL

1. Owners and riders must be members both ARCHA and NRCHA members. Waiver must be signed at show office prior to class. **Copy of NRCHA cards must be submitted with entries.**
2. After each work, headstalls must be dropped and viewed by the appointed representative and mouth checked. Use of illegal &/or training equipment will not be permitted in the show arena on the day of the show, either one hour previous to show time or during the performance. Training equipment will be permitted in the outside warm-up arena only.
3. Exhibitors must wear a western hat or helmet approved for riding by an equine organization, boots & long sleeve shirt, chaps or chinks are mandatory. On show day & until the conclusion of the show, any persons entering the show pen must be wearing a western hat and long sleeve shirt.
4. An owner may enter more than one horse. A rider may ride more than one horse. A horse may only be entered once in each division.
5. The ARCHA reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. All decisions are final.
6. The ARCHA reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the event without notice &/or liability. In the event of cancellation all entry fees paid to date will be refunded. Any interest earned on the entries is the property of the ARCHA.
7. These rules & conditions are subject to change by action of the ARCHA Board of Directors &/or Committee on behalf of the ARCHA Board of Directors.

FUTURITY & DERBY

Entries must use the attached form and submitted by one of the methods below:

1. Futurity and Derby entries will be accepted until August 19. Late entries will be accepted until Aug 23 with an additional \$250.
2. Riders and owners must be members in both NRCHA and ARCHA
3. NRCHA rules apply – refer to the 2016 NRCHA rulebook for complete rules and regulations.
4. By submitting an entry, in any format, the contestant acknowledges that they meet the criteria to compete in the classes entered according to the guidelines set forth in the NRCHA rulebook.
5. **Futurity Entries:** All Futurity classes open to 3 year old horses of any breed. All horses are to be shown in 3 rounds of competition: herd, rein & cow work. Horses may have been previously exhibited in a snaffle bit, hackamore or bridle; however, they may not have been shown down the fence in a bridle.
6. **Derby Entries:** Open to horses 4 & 5 years of age of any breed that have never been shown in a bridle down the fence at any judged cow horse event held anytime, anyplace. Horses to be shown in an approved hackamore with closed reins, or approved snaffle bit in herd, rein & cow work rounds of competition (must use same equipment in all three events).
7. All entries must provide a copy of the horse's registration papers or a written veterinary age authentication including complete horse description for unregistered horses. Failure to include a copy of registration papers or veterinary age authentication will constitute an incomplete entry.
8. If horse is unregistered and entered in a non pro class, contestant must provide proof of ownership. Non pros can't show under a transfer report, the registration must be transferred to the contestant prior to the show.
9. Open and Limited Open – One fee enters riders in the eligible classes. Payout split 80/20.

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10. Non Pro and Novice Non Pro – One fee enters riders in the eligible classes. Payout split 80/20.

HORSE SHOW

1. Entries are due Friday, August 19th with the exception of the hackamore classes which can be entered up to 5:00 pm Saturday, September 3rd (no late fee). Late entries to August 23 will be an additional \$50 per class.
2. Can be entered using attached entry forms (email or fax) or the ARCHA online system www.cowhorse.ca, (Cow Horse Shows tab, follow the link to Weekend Show Entry form – **only fill out Saturday form**), or method above. By submitting an entry online, you agree to the following:
By my entry submission I hereby acknowledge that I meet the criteria to compete in the classes entered according to the guidelines.
3. Copy of horse papers must be submitted to office prior to showing.
4. NRCHA rules apply unless class is specifically identified as an ARCHA class, in which ARCHA rules will apply.
5. NRCHA \$1,000 Limit Rein Box. Eligibility is based on NRCHA earnings. If you enter ARCHA and NRCHA class you must use legal bit for age of horse.
6. There in one show over the three days, Friday, Saturday & Sunday – see schedule.
7. Classes that are NRCHA approved, one entry fee qualifies you for both NRCHA and ARCHA year end points, subject to eligibility. Payout is based on NRCHA and you ride for points for ARCHA. In the case of novice non pro bridle and limited open classes, there may be a possibility where you are eligible for NRCHA but not ARCHA. You can still enter the class, same fee, but you will not be included in the ARCHA year end points.
8. Classes that run concurrent (common draw) are as follows:
 - a. Open/Limited Open Bridle/Zytkene's Canada's Greatest prelims (all but non pro division)
 - b. Non Pro/Intermediate/Novice Non Pro Bridle/Non Pro Select//Zytkene's Canada's Greatest prelims (non pro) only
 - c. Bridle Classics//Zytkene's Canada's Greatest herd work prelims
 - d. Open/Limited Open Hackamore
 - d. NRCHA and ARCHA Youth (Under 18) Rein/box
 - e. NRCHA and ARCHA Youth (Under 18) Bridle
 - f. \$5,000 Limited and Non Pro Limited
9. See entry form for cross entry discount(s).
10. Riders are responsible to check in to office prior to class to verify entry.
11. In the event of a tie, the total cow work score will be the tie breaker for determination of awarding prizes. If there is still a tie, the contestants will flip a coin to determine prize winner.

RANCH HAND CLASSES

1. In order to enter the Ranch Hand Class you cannot have any earnings in any Cow Horse or Rein/Box event prior to January 10 of the current year. Riders are responsible for being aware of their earnings in all judged cow horse events (not just ARCHA approved) and enter only those limit classes for which they are eligible. Contact Equistat at 1 (817) 737-6397 or equistat.com, if unsure. If a limit class rider reaches the limit during the course of the show season, said rider may still remain in that class for the duration of the year.
2. Equipment can be any legal, ARCHA, AQHA equipment (one hand or two hand is optional). Snaffle Bit, Hackamore, one handed Romal rein or 1 or 2 split reins. Either leather or chain curb straps can be used (a chin strap is required). Chaps are not mandatory.
3. Both classes will use a “Ranch Hand” reined work pattern, no lead changes and 1.5 spins.

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BRIDLE SPECTACULARS

1. This is a 3-part class with herd work, rein work, and cow work. The entry must also be entered in at least one horse show class for Open, Non Pro or Novice Non Pro Bridle, or Non Pro Rein/Box, or \$5,000 Limit Rein/Box.
2. Spectacular fee is in addition to the horse show class fee.
3. In the herd work only, romal reins can be held in one hand.
4. Preliminary herd works for Zylkene's Canada's Greatest Horseman will be held concurrently (eg. Open in Open, Non pro in non pro).



ZYLKENE'S CANADA'S GREATEST HORSEMAN

1. Preliminary works will be held within other classes (eg. rein/fence portion of preliminary works will be held with the Open Bridle, Non Pro Bridle, and Novice Non Pro Bridle). The preliminary herd works will be held within the Bridle Classic herd work classes. The entry does NOT have to enter the bridle spectacular, but preliminaries will be run at the same time, and will receive cross-entry discounts (see entry form).
2. Open to all breeds of horses of all ages regardless of show history.
3. Contestants will compete in four go-rounds: herd, rein, steer stopping, and cow work.
4. The Zylkene's Canada Greatest Horseman contest will have only one division (Open). A Non Pro jackpot will be held within the contest. Non Pros will be automatically entered into the Non Pro jackpot (no additional fees).
5. An owner may enter more than one horse and/or a rider may ride more than one horse. Note: Non pro ownership rules still apply.
6. Horses must be shown in the same NRCHA legal bridle throughout all phases, no tie-downs will be permitted.
7. The traditional romal must be used. With romal reins, hand is to be around the reins in a fist position with thumb up and no fingers between the reins. In the herd work only, romal reins can be held in one hand. Roping reins are optional in the Steer Stopping.
8. Entry fees, stall fees and other charges are outlined on the entry form.
9. Entries will be accepted until August 19. After August 19, a \$250 late penalty will be applied up until August 23.
10. Scoring of the herd, reined, steer stopping and cow portions of this contest will be in accordance with the NRCHA rules.
11. Bits will be checked after each go-round. A score of zero will be given for pink or bloody mouth on the horse.
12. Horse and rider must compete in all four go-rounds to qualify for go-round money, unless the horse or rider is physically unable to compete.
13. There will be five finalists that will compete in the finals the last day of the contest (regardless of Open or Non pro status). The highest scoring Non pro (whether in the finals or not will win the \$2,500 non pro jackpot).
14. Finalists start with a clean slate, and must pay a \$330 finals fee. If a tie advances more than the specified number of finalists to be paid, the payout may be adjusted according to the number of horses in the finals, but the total payout will not change. Example: If there are 6 horses taken to the finals with ties, all 6 will be figured in the payout which will be reworked but the amount will stay the same.
15. \$500 will be paid to the high score in each of the preliminary events.
16. Payout will be as follows: 1st place: \$10,000. 2nd place: 40% of purse, 3rd place: 30% of purse, 4th place: 20% of purse, 5th place: 10% of purse.
17. The highest scoring Non Pro will win the \$2,500 jackpot.
18. NRCHA Rules and regulations will apply in all other instances.

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SCRATCHES

If an entry is scratched on or before August 23, 2016, any prepaid fees will be returned and/or the entrant will not be responsible for fees. After August 23, 2016, contestant will be charged half of the office/cattle charge. No refunds will be issued after draw date, August 23.

SUBSTITUTIONS

1. Rider Substitutions: Rider substitutions can be completed by contacting the show secretary. Rider substitutions may be subject to the Snaffle Bit Committee's approval (i.e. Non-Pro).
2. Horse Substitutions: In order to complete a horse substitution, the following items must be sent to the show secretary:
 - A veterinary note explaining the reason the horse is not able to be shown.
 - A copy of the new entry's registration papers or veterinary age authentication (Futurity & Derby classes only).
 - A new entry form must be completed.
3. Change of ownership: If any entry changes ownership, the entry will retain eligibility by complying with the following:
 - Notification of change in ownership to the show secretary.
 - New owner is or becomes a member of the ARCHA.

PAYMENT

1. **All entries must accompany a credit card number on the entry form; however, you have the option to pay by cheque or cash, VISA, or Mastercard.** For credit card payment, add 4%. Payment may be submitted with entry or paid at show.
2. **Cheques payable to: Alberta Reined Cow Horse Association**
3. Payments returned due to insufficient funds will be subject to all late fees upon re-entry and a \$50 NSF charge will also be assessed. Owners and/or contestants with payments returned due to insufficient funds will be reported to the NRCHA office and subject to NRCHA penalties (refer to NRCHA rulebook).
4. All entries will be acknowledged by email or phone.
