1. Entries are Due October 13th, 2024 by midnight.

2. Owners and exhibitors must be ARCHA & NRCHA members in good standing.
3. NRCHA rules apply – refer to the 2024 NRCHA Rulebook for complete rules and regulations.
4. Derby/Futurity entries must provide a copy of the horse's registration papers or a written veterinary age authentication including complete horse description for unregistered horses.
5. All entries must provide a copy of the horse's registration papers. If horse in unregistered, owner must submit NRCHA Grade Horse Competition License. **Non-Pro's cannot show under transfer report/bill of sale, the registration must be transferred to the contestant prior to the show.**

6. Cow Horse Show – NRCHA rules apply unless class is specifically identified as an ARCHA class, in which ARCHA rules will apply (\$2,000 Limit Working Cow Horse, Buckaroo Youth Boxing, Ranch Hand Boxing).
7. One payout per show based on NRCHA payout schedule.
8. Classes that run concurrently (common draw) are as follows:
 - a. Roger Brown Memorial Open/Limited Open Futurity
 - b. Open/Limited Open Derby
 - c. Non-Pro/ Intermediate/ L1/Select Non Pro Bridle
 - d. Open/Intermediate/Limited Open Bridle
 - e. Non-Pro/Intermediate Boxing
9. Exhibitors are responsible to check in to office Prior to class to verify entry.
10. The CSBF Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. All decisions are final.
11. The CSBF Committee reserves the right to cancel classes pending an acceptable number of entries.
12. The CSBF Committee reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the event without notice &/or liability. In the event of cancellation all entry fees paid to date will be refunded.
- 13. Draws will be posted after 5pm the night before the following days classes.**

Stalls

- Move in on Thursday October 24th after 2pm

- Additional shavings must be purchased directly from Calnash Ag Event Centre Barn Office
- Haul in fee \$25 / entry if no stalls booked

Scratches

- Scratches made on or before October 15th at midnight will be refunded any fees prepaid, and not responsible for any fees.
- Scratches made after the entry date (October 15th at midnight) and before the draw date (October 21,2024) will be responsible for the add back and half cattle/office fee.
- Scratches made after the draw date (October 21,2024) will be responsible for all fees and as per NRCHA rules will remain listed on the posted draws.

Late Entries

- Late entries will be accepted up to draw date (October 21,2024) with the following late fees:
 - LAE Classes \$200
 - Horse Show Classes \$75
- Late entries on or after the draw date may be accepted based on show management approval, with late fee. Please contact Show Secretary

Substitutions

- Exhibitor substitutions can be completed by contacting the show secretary. Exhibitor substitutions may be subject to the CSBF Committee's approval.
- Horse Substitutions: To complete a horse substitution, the following items must be submitted to the show secretary:
 - A copy of the new entry's registration papers or veterinary age authentication.
 - A new entry form must be completed.

Payment of Fees

- Entry fees are payable by cheque, e-transfer, credit card (4% fee) or cash
- **Show tabs must be closed prior to end of show on Sunday, or a \$50/day fine will be attached for each day tab goes unpaid.**

CSBF Super Spectacular

- 4 Events: Herd, Steer Stopping, Reining, Fence
- Herd work will run following the Futurity herd work on Friday
- Steer Stopping will be held Friday after the days classes
- Horse Show 1 will be used for the reined work/cow work scores. Must enter the corresponding class (Open/Limited Open Bridle/Level 1, Intermediate/Non-Pro Bridle) for score to count.
- Boxing exhibitors are welcome to enter, and a Boxing Champion will be determined.
 - Youth, Limited, Intermediate, Non-Pro Boxing classes will be used to determine the reined work/cow work scores. NRCHA class must be entered.
- Aggregate scores will be tallied to determine the Champion
- NRCHA Steer Stopping Rules will apply

Clayton Hines Memorial Fence Challenge
